Welcome to my 2020 list. I am very happy to be able to offer a particularly good number of famous Irish breeder Brian Duncan's very desirable new miniatures again. These are in very limited numbers, so you will have to be very quick! Also in this year's list are a number of larger species, and a rare opportunity to obtain some of Brian's crosses which aim to produce small daffodils for open garden planting, designed to have the grace and elegance of wild or historic varieties. These have been a delight in my garden this spring, and elicited much comment from visitors. I recommend you email in your order as soon as possible. *If you wish to telephone, I will note the time of your request and slot it into the appropriate place among the email requests.*

PLEASE NOTE – MOST ITEMS ARE IN VERY LIMITED NUMBERS, SO PLEASE APPLY EARLY, LAST DATE FOR ORDERS END OF JULY 2020 ALL ITEMS OFFERED SUBJECT TO SUCCESSFUL HARVEST.

UK and EU orders will be sent as soon as I can. Orders to outside the EU will all be sent together end of July/ August, as they will all need to be inspected together by FERA before dispatch. All plants are flowering size, unless otherwise specified.

POSTAGE AND PACKING- -£5-50 per order. I am asking for less than the actual cost of delivery and packaging. If your order can be sent as Large Letter, I will refund any extra postage. Parcels will be sent by first class post, recorded delivery, so will need to be signed for. Orders can be collected from my home address if you are in the area.

EU Postage and Packaging - £10.

USA Costs have increased dramatically since last year. I'm therefore asking for a contribution of £35 to the cost of phytosanitary certification will be added to the actual cost of shipping. I will make a loss on this.

NARCISSUS SPECIES

I've had some feedback from Spanish botanists about the naming of the larger species. The names comply with the RHS Botanical list, which was last updated in 2018, but it seems there has been much lumping and renaming in the last few years, and conflict between different taxonomists, largely because of more observation in the wild leading to more understanding of variation within a single species. From a horticultural standpoint, plants can look very different, whereas botanically they may turn out to be just different morphs of the same species. No doubt as more DNA analysis is used, there will be further name changes. This will pose problems for nurseries selling bulbs as it is not helpful to the customer to offer distinctly different (to the eye) plants under a single name, and is something that will need to be addressed.

I do not have the knowledge to make decisions about naming, and am using the names I was given along with the bulbs, so if you would like to know the names that have been suggested as alternatives, I list them here and in brackets on the list.

If you are buying for a specific species/subspecies, I cannot give you a 100% definitive identification. It would be great if all the taxonomists could come to an agreement, but that seems very unlikely in the near future, so I am offering the larger species **as seen in the photo**. What you see is what you will get. Even if the names are unclear, they still make wonderful garden plants.
